Engagement.

During March, SNT officers attended Donnington and Boscobel Parish Council Meeting. Lots of issues were discussed and how the police and council can work together. PC Mandy Cooper also attended the Albrighton Parish Council meeting where councillors had the opportunity to share local concerns. A warrant was conducted at a property in Shifnal, we continue to be proactive and execute warrants on the information received from the public. Thank you for your help, it is only by the police and the public working together that we can prevent and detect crime.



Joint Partnership Working

SNT have made multiple visits into schools and workplaces this month, strengthening our partnership working. A meeting was held with pupils on the student council of Idsall, which included a Shifnal resident coming into to speak about his recent experience about ASB in the town. We have also been to speak with staff at a local care company about safety whilst out walking late at night. PC Mandy Cooper along with PCSO's Newbrook and Breese have been into Shifnal Primary School to deliver a workshop around hate crime, bullying/harassment and cyber safety. Year 5's and 6's took part in the workshop which included quizzes, mind maps and lots of positive interaction.

Anti social behaviour

At the tail end of February we saw the installation of a CCTV camera in the Brookdale area of Shifnal. Since this has been installed we have seen a decrease in the amount of people gathering and causing nuisance in the area. Our multi agency approach to solve the problems at Brookdale will continue in the coming months, when we will see the benches removed. SNT also responded to reports of an abandoned vehicle. Upon further enquiries the vehicle was found to be stolen. It was subsequently recovered for forensic examination.
