## Engagement.

During February, SNT officers attended our monthly Shifnal Law and Order meeting. Issues for the area were raised and discussed with councillors, partner agencies and police. Officers have also conducted regular safer outside school patrols at St Andrews in Shifnal and St Mary's in Albrighton. A car was seized for no tax and insurance after one of our afternoon patrols outside of St Mary's. Numerous motorists have also been spoken to over the course of the month in regards to safe and correct parking outside of school.



## Rural and Business Crime Team.

West Mercia Police has a Rural and Business Crime Team who specialise in all aspects of Rural Crime, Wildlife Crime, Business Crime and Heritage Crime. ## Anti-social behaviour

Over the last few months we have seen an increase in ASB in the Brookdale area of Shifnal. SNT have increased patrols around Brookdale, spoken with residents and are working alongside Shifnal Town Council to reduce the ASB. As a result the Council have installed a CCTV camera in the Brookdale area. Antisocial behaviour takes many forms, from aggressive, noisy or abusive behaviour to neighbourhood disturbances involving drugs or animals.
