## YOU SAID WE DID

### Speed Surveys

Having spoken with members of the public and receiving reports on Neighbourhood matters, we have conducted speed surveys on:

- Station Road Admaston- in a 30mph zone the average speed was 25mph, with 5 vehicles seen to be driving in excess of 30mph.
- Marton drive, Brooklands- in a 30mph zone the average speed was 23mph, with 3 vehicles seen to be driving in excess of 30mph.
- Whitchurch Road, Dothill- in a 30mph zone the average speed was 31mph, with 23 vehicles seen to be driving in excess of 30mph. Due to this we will be conducting a speed enforcement for this area.

### Safer Outside Schools (SOS)

The Wellington North Team have been conducting SOS outside our 5 schools. We have been splitting our days between St Peter's Bratton, St Patricks and Wrekin View North Road, Dothill Primary and Charlton Secondary. Our aim is to ensure children are safe getting to and from school, by advising and moving on vehicles who may be parked on double yellows, zig-zags or on junctions.



### Pemberton Road Car Park, Admaston

Officers from Wellington North continue to conduct high visibility patrols of Pemberton Road and Admaston House car park due to reports of ASB. Whilst on patrol, officers' attention was drawn to a vehicle on Pemberton Road car park. The occupants of the car were searched due to the smell of cannabis coming from the car.

We are keen to stop ASB and are currently working with Telford and Wrekin Council for this area. Please contact the team if you wish to report ASB in your area.
